
Stephanie Ellis is a Wrexham-based writer of dark fiction and a Rhysling and Elgin Award nominated poet.




FOLK HORROR


POST-APOCALYPTIC/DYSTOPIAN






STORIES IN VERSE



COSY CRIME/MYSTERY





Found poetry is an act of creation in its own right. By taking words already in existence in the works of others, something completely new can be created.






